Rivers Police Board held four meetings in 2015:

February 5, May 14, September 10, November 12 - Regular Board Meetings (minutes attached)

In 2015, Rivers Police Board focused on developing our Policy Manual. We are thankful to Altona Police Board, who took the initiative to develop theirs and then share with other Police Boards. Rivers Policy Manual will be finalized early in 2016.

2015 has been the first year for the new Riverdale Municipality, with Town of Rivers and Daly Municipality amalgamating. Councillor Bryan Smith has been keeping the Police Board up to date on the amalgamation process and how Rivers Police fits into that amalgamation.

Rivers Police Board supported the request sent out by Winnipeg Police Board to start an informal provincial Police Board Association.

Community involvement and accountability remained priorities for the Police Board again throughout 2015. This can be seen in the following:
