

RIVERDALE MUNICIPALITY BY-LAW 2015-07

Being a By-Law to close part of a municipal road shown as a road allowance in the Dominion Government Survey.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

290(1) "Subject to subsection (2), a municipality may close a municipal road by:

- a) passing a by-law closing the road;
- b) obtaining the written approval of the by-law from the Minister; and
- c) registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office."

AND WHEREAS the following described municipal road is no long required for public purposes and it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the road be **closed**;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Riverdale Municipality enacts as follows:

1. THAT all that portion of the municipal road being a road allowance in the Dominion Government Survey, located between the South East Quarter of Section 23 and South West Quarter of Section 24, Township 12, Range 21 WPM, as shown on a plan prepared by Timothy William Longstaff, Manitoba Land Surveyor, on the 28th of October 2014, and sworn to by him on the 15th of May, 2015, be and the same is hereby closed.
2. THAT the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the closed road.
