Being a by-law of Riverdale Municipality to establish the recovery of costs incurred by the Riverdale Fire Department for services provided outside municipality or beyond normal emergency response

WHEREAS the Council of Riverdale Municipality deems it expedient and in the best interest of the Municipality to establish rates for the recovery of costs of providing fire protection and related services to areas outside the Municipality with which it has no agreement for compensation for fire protection services, and for the recovery of costs of providing fire protection and related services beyond normal emergency response;

THEREFORE, THE RIVERDALE MUNICIPALITY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Riverdale Municipality hereby implement the rate structure for the recovery of fire protection costs outside the Municipality, in the form and substance hereto attached as Schedule "A" to this By-law;
- 2. That the Chief Administrative Officer be hereby authorized, empowered, and directed, to execute and fulfill the terms of the attached Schedule "A".

SCHEDULE OF RATES FOR RECOVERY OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES & EQUIPMENT PROVIDED OUTSIDE OF THE BOUNDARIES OF RIVERDALE MUNICIPALITY WHERE NO RELATED AGREEMENT EXISTS AND/OR FOR SERVICES PROVIDED TO OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTS & JURISDICTIONS, GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES, CROWN CORPORATIONS, AND PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS, CORPORATIONS, AND BUSINESSES OUTSIDE OF THE SCOPE OF NORMAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE.

Fees for the Rescue (Rescue Unit) include use of rescue equipment, rescue sleigh, and all terrain vehicle.

2. Fire Department Personnel

\$25.00 per hour for each member as required. This cost includes round trip travel time, actual duty work, and equipment clean-up.

The following shall be the minimum personnel complements per apparatus deployed:

Engine (Pumper Truck)	4 personnel
Rescue (Rescue Van)	2 personnel
Tanker (Tanker Truck)	1 personnel
Wildland (Foam Truck)	2 personnel
Zodiac (water rescue)	1 personnel

The minimum complement of personnel is 4. In the event that the service provided includes use of rescue equipment, rescue sleigh, or all terrain vehicle, the minimum complement of personnel shall be 6.

3. Portable Fire Extinguishers

Actual recharge value per extinguisher.

4. Foam

Actual replacement cost per gallon.

5. Administration

10% of total invoice.
