Newton have expressed concerns regarding increased salinity, time frames for shutting down the pumps, characteristics of the streambed and whether it is channelized or spread out, and effects on a dry channel where there is no dilution factor present. Frontier Drainage is to provide answers to Councils questions as well as more in-depth research on the effects on landowners farther than the 2 mile minimum.
