



## Community Market in RIVERDALE

Riverdale Recreation Commission is bringing a Community Market to Riverdale Municipality! This will be a new service, that has not been operated in the past and we want you to be a part of it!

We invite all home-based businesses wanting to sell their goods to purchase a table for the season. This includes any home-based vendors (Mary Kay, Usborne, 31 Gifts, Scentsy, etc), handmade art/crafts, and of course, FOOD!

### **FARMERS MARKET RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. All vendors must submit a registration form prior to setting up their table. Registration forms can be obtained through the RCC Office or on site
2. All market vendors will be given a copy of the 2017 Farmers Market Guidelines set out by the Province of Manitoba to adhere by
3. Market Fee: A one-time flat fee of \$35.00 will administered to each vendor. This fee applies to walk ins as well. This fee will cover your spot for the entire season
4. Markets will take place on Wednesdays from 4:30-6:30pm in the Riverdale Community Centre Parking Lot.
5. Vendors are able to set up their table one hour early, but cannot start selling their product until 4:30pm on Wednesday
6. Vendors are responsible for providing their own table. If you require a table, please request this in your registration form.
7. Access to power & water is NOT available
8. Vendors are responsible for picking up their garbage at the end of each night

### **PROVINCIAL GUIDELINES**

All home packaged food shall be labelled identifying the following:

- Source (producer name or identity code, and phone number)
- Common name of food
- Ingredients
- Date the food was prepared

As per Manitoba Health, below is a list of goods that is eligible to be made at home and brought to a farmers/community market for sale:

Manitoba Health Outlines Potentially Hazardous Foods that are unable to be made AT HOME and then sold at Farmers Markets. If these foods are produced at approved food handling establishments (Riverdale Community Centre is an approved food handling establishment) they are able to be sold at farmers markets.
