



Riverdale Municipality is closely monitoring the COVID-19 outbreak and we encourage all ratepayers to follow the recommendations below set out by the Provincial and Federal Governments to reduce the spread of the virus:

- Social Distancing
 - Minimizing prolonged (more than 10 minutes), close (less than two meters/six feet) contact between individuals in public
 - Avoid greetings which involve touching such as handshakes
 - Disinfecting frequently used surfaces
 - Following public health related to self-monitoring and self-isolation if you have travelled or have been exposed to someone ill with the virus, and
 - Considering avoiding travel, crowded places and events, especially if you are at higher risk (e.g. seniors and those with underlying health conditions)
- Follow proper cough etiquette and hand hygiene

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth
- Disinfect frequently used surfaces
- Self-Isolate if you have any of the following symptoms:
 - Fever
 - Coughing
 - Difficulty breathing/shortness of breath
 - Sneezing

Symptoms can take up to 14 days to appear so self-monitoring is important! The elderly and those with underlying medical conditions are most at risk, so please take all precautions to keep everyone safe!
