



Please be advised that due to the growing concern of the COVID-19 outbreak Riverdale Municipality is actively taking precautions to better protect our staff and residents. **Until Further Notice Riverdale Municipal Office, Water Treatment Plant, Riverdale Recreation Centre, and Public Works Buildings will be closed to the public for all non-essential business.**

For essential services the public will be screened prior to entry, if you have a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, or sneezing or have travelled outside the country in the last 14 days access into the building will not be granted.

In order to ensure that business continues we encourage residents to make payments online if they bank with a Credit Union, Royal Bank of Canada, or CIBC. If you are unable to make payments through these web-based services a drop box will be located at the Riverdale Municipal Office just inside the main doors and a receipt will be sent in the mail.

The following **will be** asked for all utility calls prior to entry into the home so our staff may take any and all necessary precautions to ensure everyone's safety:

- Have you travelled outside the country within the last 14 days?
- Are you currently experiencing any of the following?
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Difficulty Breathing
 - Sneezing
