



DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

June 30, 2020

No. 163-20 DYER-FALKEVITCH

WHEREAS Riverdale Municipality is encountering overland flooding due to heavy rains, that requires prompt action to prevent harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of persons located within the boundaries, of Riverdale Municipality and to prevent damage to property within those boundaries.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT pursuant to Section 11(1) of The Emergency Measures Act, Chapter. E80 of the Continuing Consolidation of the Statutes of Manitoba, the Council of Riverdale Municipality declares that a state of local emergency exists, Riverdale Municipality, from this 29 day of June 2020 to the 29 day of July, 2020.
