



Riverdale Municipality invites tenders for removal and disposal of five (5) trees and ten (10) 10” stumps through the Dutch Elm Disease Maintenance Program in the Town of Rivers. Only trees on the specified list will be reimbursed for removal, a copy of this list can be obtained from the municipal office.

**Trees must be removed flush with the ground to the soil line.**

- Equipment used to cut trees must be disinfected with methyl hydrate before servicing other healthy elms.
- Contractor is responsible to ensure wood from removed elms is chipped or destroyed right away, and in accordance with the legislation.
- Contractor is responsible for removing all debris and ensuring the site is clean after removal.
- Contractor will be responsible for all remediation if damage occurs to the property.

Contractor must comply with the Forest Health Protection Act, Dutch Elm Disease Maintenance Program, and all other regulations and legislation. The municipality is not responsible for any damage that might occur during the removal of trees.

Removal of all trees and debris must be complete and ready for final inspection prior to March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Contractor is responsible to communicate with the Operations Manager prior to commencement of work.

Please have your tender enclosed in a sealed envelope labelled “Dutch Elm Tree Removal Tender 2024” and delivered to the municipal office prior to March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 by 12:00 Noon.
