If you have experienced frozen lines in the past

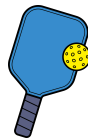
If we've turned off your by-pass valve in the past (let us know and we will be sure it's turned on!)

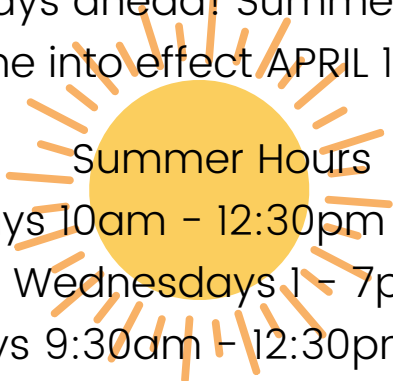
