E-Bike/E-Scooter Information

E-BIKES AND E-SCOOTERS ARE NOT TOYS – RIDE SAFELY AND RESPONSIBLY!

Helmets are required when operating a power-assisted e-bike. A helmet is always a smart choice when riding any electric device.

Stop at stop signs, obey traffic signals and watch for pedestrians, vehicles and other pathway users.

Speed, stunts and careless riding can lead to serious injuries. Always ride with care and keep your eyes on where you're going.

Don't carry passengers unless your equipment is specifically designed and equipped to do so safely.

If riding at night, make sure your bike or device has the proper lights and reflectors.

Know what you're riding! E-bikes and e-scooters may be subject to different rules depending on the type, motor and speed of the device.
