THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Municipality hereby appoints Marci Quane as the Senior Election Official (SEO) for the 2026 Municipal General Election, with authority to carry out all duties prescribed under The Municipal Councils and School Boards Elections Act and related regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the SEO shall have full authority to appoint election officials, establish voting places, and perform all other functions necessary to ensure the fair and efficient conduct of the election.
