WHEREAS Section 365(2) of The Municipal Act provides that Council may in any year designate the immediately preceding year, or any earlier year, as the year for which

properties, the taxes in respect of which are in arrears for the year, must be offered for sale by auction to recover the tax arrears and costs,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Designated Year for which properties in arrears be offered for sale by auction, be 2025 (meaning all properties with outstanding taxes from the year 2024 or prior); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT in accordance with s. 363 (1) of the Municipal Act, “costs” shall be the actual costs incurred for each parcel listed for the tax sale [plus administration fees of \$50.00 as set forth in Manitoba Regulation 50/97]; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the tax sale be held October 19th, 2026 at 10:00 am at the Riverdale Municipality council chambers.
