4.2 Municipal Fire Ban

No. 254-475 **CREIGHTON - MASON**

WHEREAS Riverdale Municipality is empowered under By-law 2016-06 Fire Prevention and Control of Wildland Fires to protect life and property by regulating outdoor burning activities within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) may impose a burning ban under Section 3.1 of the said by-law when weather or environmental conditions create a high risk of wildfires;

Therefore Be It Resolved that Riverdale Municipality bans all open, outdoor burning which including grass, leaves, crop residue, and bushes;

Fires contained within CSA- or ULC-certified fire pits or outdoor solid fuel burning appliances, provided they are used in accordance with manufacturer guidelines and local regulations.
