VOTING PLACES

Voting places will be open for voting on Wednesday the 28th day of October, 2026 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

at: Royal Canadian Legion Hall, 633 – 2nd Ave, Rivers MB

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at the Riverdale Municipal Civic Centre Council Chambers, 670 – 2nd Ave Rivers MB and will be open during each of the following days October 21st, 2026 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following health care facilities on election day:

1. Riverdale Personal Care Home, Solarium 9:00am – 10:00am

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, by email, or by fax to the senior election official at Box 520, Rivers MB R0K 1X0, cao@riverdalemb.ca or fax: 204-328-5374.

If applying in person*, a voter may apply between September 30th and October 25th, 2026.

* A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application. All voters should bring identification when requesting a sealed envelope ballot.

If applying by mail or fax**, a voter may apply between July 30th and October 25th, 2026.

** A voter applying by mail, email or fax will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the senior election official.
