TOWN OF RIVERS BY-LAW NO. 08-2012

BEING	Α	BY-LAW	OF	THE	TOWN	OF	RIVERS	FOR	THE		
PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A POLICE BOARD											

WHEREAS Section 26(1) of *The Police Services Act, C.C.S.M., Cap. P94.5*, provides as follows:

26(1) Every municipality that operates a police service must establish and maintain a police board in accordance with this Division."

AND WHEREAS Section 30(1) of The Police Services Act provides in part as follows:

- 30 (1) The Council of a municipality must establish the size of its police board by by-law. The police board must
 - a) consist of at least three members, in the case of a municipality with a population under 5,000

NOW THEREFORE THE TOWN OF RIVERS, in Council assembled, enacts as a bylaw as follows:

- 1. A Police Board for the Town of Rivers is hereby established.
- 2. The Board shall consist of three (3) members.
- 3. The members shall be appointed as follows:
 - a. One (1) member of Council or an employee of the Municipality appointed by resolution of council;
 - b. One (1) residents appointed by resolution of council, who are neither members of council nor employees of the Town of Rivers
 - c. One (1) member appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
- 4. Council shall appoint the chair and vice-chair of the police board by resolution of council.
- 5. Remuneration to members of the police board who are not members of council or employees of the municipality shall be set by resolution of council.

DONE and PASSED as a By-law of the Town of Rivers at Rivers, Manitoba in the Province of Manitoba this 4th day of December, 2012.
