

**RIVERDALE MUNICIPALITY
BY-LAW NO. 2017-04**

Being a By-Law of the Riverdale Municipality to close a portion of a municipal road, as amended
.....

WHEREAS:

A. Section 290 of *The Municipal Act* authorizes a municipality to close a municipal road by passing a by-law closing the road, obtaining the written approval of the minister, and registering the approved by-law and a plan in the appropriate land title office.

NOW THEREFORE the Riverdale Municipality in Council assembled enacts as a by-law the following:

1. The portion of a municipal road described as follows is hereby closed:

All that portion of the Government Road Allowance which lies between the Frac. NE 33-10-20 WPM and SE ¼ 3-11-20 WPM now shown as Parcel A on a Plan of Survey prepared by Gary R. Pawluk, of the R.M. of Cornwallis, Manitoba Land Surveyor, sworn to by him on the 30th day of January, 2017 and on record in the Property Registry as Deposit 1891-2016.

2. Following the closing the land shall be conveyed, except all mines and minerals and other matters as set forth in The Crown Lands Act, to the owners of

and consolidated with their existing title.

3. The Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer are authorized to execute all documents necessary to carry out the provisions of this By-law.
