7.1 Memorial Drive – Speed Limit

No. 201-19 FALKEVITCH-CREIGHTON

Whereas Manitoba Infrastructure is the traffic authority on provincial roadways;

And Whereas PR 664 (Memorial Drive) runs through the community of Rivers;

And Whereas the speed limit on a stretch of 2,200 M between the Provincial Park access to 260M West of the corner of PR 250 & PR 664 is 90km/hr;

And Whereas current development will create 17 new residential lots, with 9 new approaches onto PR 664;

And Whereas PR 664 serves as the main route in and out of Rivers Provincial Park;

And Whereas increased traffic has made it unsafe for residents along PR 664, and will continue to increase with development;

And Whereas it is common for pedestrian traffic walking to and from the Provincial Park from Rivers;

Therefore Be It Resolved That Riverdale Municipality submit a change request for initiating a review of the speed limit on this section of PR 664.
